Public Advisory: Dispelling claims by a “Nthabiseng Ramokolo” purporting to be a pharmacist

The South African Pharmacy Council (SAPC) can confirm that, after investigation, we have found no record of a “Nthabiseng Ramokolo” on the Register of pharmacists. The claimed credentials, i.e. Community Service Pharmacist, Junior Pharmacist, listed on the LinkedIn profile of “Nthabiseng Ramokolo” do not align with any information on our registers.

We will be pursuing a criminal case in terms of Section 29(1)(b) of the Pharmacy Act, 53 of 1974, which in part speaks to the penalties for professing to be or practising as a pharmacist while unregistered with the SAPC.

The SAPC strongly discourages this behaviour and encourages members of the public to utilise the resources available on our website to search and verify registered pharmacists and pharmacies.
