**NB!!!** Entrance requirements for the EISA are as follows:

**Learner Post-Basic Occupational Certificate Pharmacist's Assistant:**

- Completed a minimum of 12 months of training with an accredited provider and must have;
- Successfully completed Knowledge, Practical and Work Experience modules;
- Received a statement of results from the provider; and
- Written the Practice EISA.

**Currently qualified Pharmacist's Assistants (Post-Basic):**

- Registered qualified Pharmacist's Assistant (Post-Basic); and
- Written the Practice EISA.

**Learner Post-Basic - Former BPharm student:**

- Registration as a Learner Post-Basic - Former BPharm student
- Completed 400hrs in an approved pharmacy and under the direct personal supervision of a pharmacist;
- Submitted at least one progress report; and
- Written the Practice EISA.
