SAPC e-Note: Removal of Orphaned Learners

The South African Pharmacy Council wishes to inform you that your name has been removed from the Register of Pharmacist's Assistants due to the lack of an approved Tutor, in terms of Regulation 32(b) of the *Regulations relating to the registration of persons and the maintenance of registers*, promulgated under the Pharmacy Act, 53 of 1974.

Consequently, your registration certificate is considered cancelled. If you have an approved and registered Tutor and believe that your removal from the Register was effected in error, you are requested to contact Customer Care immediately to enable Council to investigate the issue and, where appropriate, effect the necessary correction. Upon securing an approved Tutor, you may submit an online application to restore your name to the Register.
