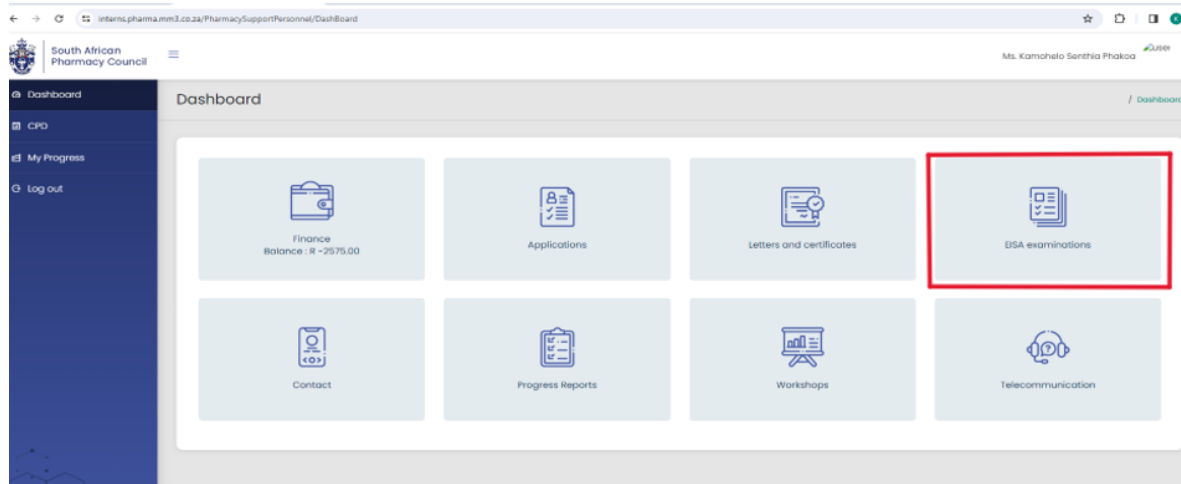

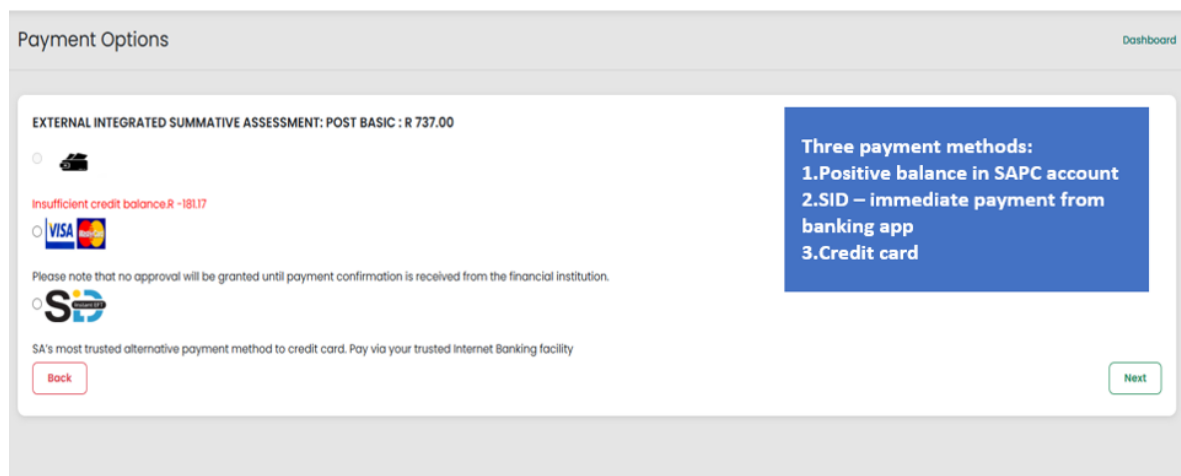
Late bookings will be accepted until 29 September 2026; however, a late booking fee of R1,104.00 is payable.

NB!!! Entrance requirements for the EISA are as follows:

Learner Post-Basic Occupational Certificate Pharmacist's Assistant:

- Completed a minimum of 12 months of training with an accredited provider and must have;
- Successfully completed Knowledge, Practical and Work Experience modules;
- Received a statement of results from the provider; and
- Written the Practice EISA.

Currently qualified Pharmacist's Assistants (Post-Basic):

- Registered qualified Pharmacist's Assistant (Post-Basic); and
- Written the Practice EISA.

Learner Post-Basic - Former BPharm student:

- Registration as a Learner Post-Basic - Former BPharm student

- Completed 400hrs in an approved pharmacy and under the direct personal supervision of a pharmacist;
- Submitted at least one progress report; and
- Written the Practice EISA.
