The South African Pharmacy Council (SAPC) will be conducting virtual pre-reg exam workshops using Microsoft Teams on 09 and 11 May 2023. Entrance requirements for the 2023 Pharmacist Intern pre-registration examination

- Interns writing the exam for the first (1st) time must be in their sixth (6th) month of internship and must submit at least six (6) CPD entries online and be competent in at least three (3) entries. The tutor must have submitted three (3) progress reports (i.e., the 12 and 24 weeks progress reports)
- Pharmacist Interns in their ninth (9th) month must submit six (6) CPD entries and be competent in all six (6) entries. The tutor must have submitted four (4) progress reports (i.e., 12, 24 and 36 weeks progress reports)
- Interns attempting the examination for the second time (or subsequent attempts) must be competent in all six (6) CPD entries to be allowed to sit for re-examination. The tutor must have submitted the relevant progress reports according to the intern's date of registration.
